INITIAL SERVICE CHARGE

For establishing a new account with the Company \$35.00

DISCONNECTION POLICY CHARGES

Company representative call to customer's premises for purposes of:

Disconnection of Service:

1. During normal working hours \$35.00
2. Other than normal working hours \$150.00

Reconnection of Service:

1. During normal working hours \$35.00
2. Other than normal working hours \$150.00

COLLECTION OF BILL: \$35.00

RETURNED CHECKS: \$35.00/check

TEMPORARY SERVICE

For temporary services of single-phase, 240 volt,

100 amp characteristics of less: \$175.00

If a single phase pad transformer is required

to be installed just for the temporary service \$700.00

For all other temporary services, charge will be based on estimated cost. Advance payment of estimated cost is required.

LINE EXTENSION AND SERVICE CHARGES

1. See Line Extension and Services Price List tariff.
2. Rate of interest for installment payments of contributions in aid of construction of line extensions covered by the Line Extension and Services Price List tariff and Electric Line Extension Policy: 12.0%

TURNING ON LOCKED-OUT METERS (except for meters locked out under disconnection policies)

1. Other than normal working hours \$150.00

CUSTOMER 'NO POWER' CALLS

If the cause is not the Company's equipment or responsibility and if the call is made during other than normal working hours, the customers will be billed:

\$150.00

CONTRACT JOBBING ON CUSTOMER'S PREMISES

Actual costs, including labor, transportation, materials and other indirect costs. Advance payment on estimates will be required before commencement of work.

LATE PAYMENT CHARGE

Payment for service under this rate is due on presentation of the monthly bill. If the company on or before the next monthly billing date does not receive payment, a late payment charge of 1% shall be imposed upon the unpaid balance, including any prior unpaid late payment charges. The late payment charge shall be assessed on such unpaid balances once each month

after it is initially imposed on an unpaid balance, so long as a balance remains unpaid. The Late Payment charge is not applicable to residential accounts.
