

PROPOSED CUSTOMER NOTICE

GMP recently filed a request for a change in base rates to be reviewed by the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“PUC”). For October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2023, GMP is requesting the PUC approve a 2.34% base rate change. Base rates cover GMP’s projected, routine costs to serve customers with safe, reliable power. This reflects changes in power supply including from the regional energy market, operational expenses, and key investments to increase reliability and resiliency and to promote innovative services for customers. If approved, the average residential customer (using approx. 550 kWh/month) will see an increase of about \$2.63 on their monthly energy statement.

The PUC will now review this request and there are ways you can participate! You can join us for a statewide public meeting on this request held remotely on _____, 2022 at **[goto meeting link]**, or dial in by phone at ____ - ____ - _____. The public meeting will begin with an information session at 6:45 p.m. hosted by the Vermont Department of Public Service, and will be followed by a public hearing at 7:00 p.m. where you can make a public comment.
