Re: Case No. 22-__-TF – Tariff filing of Green Mountain Power to return the Power Supply, Retail Revenue and Exogenous Adjustors Cumulative Carry Forward balance

Dear Ms. Anderson:

In its Quarterly Adjustor Report (“Report”) for the second quarter of Fiscal Year 2022 (“FY2022 Q2”) filed today in Case No. 22A-1560, Green Mountain Power (“GMP”) reports on the results for the Power Supply and Retail Revenue Adjustor (“PSRRA”) and the Exogenous Major Storm Adjustor (“EMSA”). In the Report, GMP explains that we will reflect an approximately \$3.22 million customer credit, representing the Cumulative Carry Forward balance that had accrued as of the end of FY2022 Q1, on customer energy statements for a period of 12 months commencing July 1, 2022, under the process approved by the Commission in GMP’s Amended Multi-Year Regulation Plan (“MYRP”).¹ In this tariff filing to implement this adjustment, GMP submits the following:

- Clean and redlined record of filing tariff sheets, utilizing the line item adjustor as approved by the Commission;
- The Line Item Credit Calculation;
- Proposed Customer Notice;² and
- A copy of the above-referenced Report.


¹ The MYRP was originally approved in Case No. 18-1633-PET and subsequently amended in Case Nos. 20-1401-PET and 21-1965-PET.

² For the customer notice, we have utilized the previously-reviewed template for customer notice for adjustor filings, submitted to the Commission in Case No. 20-1407-TF, and have revised the language to reflect the requirements of the amended MYRP.

The proposed line item return to customers is based on a percentage of retail revenue as required by Section VI of the MYRP. As shown in the Line Item Credit Calculation, a line item reduction of 0.49% will be applied to customer energy statements for a 12-month period beginning July 1, 2022, unless otherwise requested or ordered by the Commission.
