RESIDENTIAL SERVICE RATE SCHEDULE

COMPANY DESIGNATION: 1

AVAILABLE:

Throughout the Company's service territory.

APPLICABLE:

This rate is for single-phase electric service at secondary voltage for domestic purposes in private residences, individual apartments and farms. Incidental use for other purposes will be allowed provided that the Customer's use is predominantly as specified above; otherwise, the appropriate rate in this schedule of rates shall apply for all use unless residential use is separately measured. This rate shall not apply to entities engaged in farming where there is no domestic use.

RATE:

\$0.554 per day plus \$0.18989 per kWh

ADJUSTMENT:

This rate schedule is subject to adjustment.

ADDITIONAL SERVICE CONDITIONS:

- 1) Not available for service at locations where consumption exceeds an average of 7,600 kWh during any four consecutive billing months. Customers whose average monthly consumption exceeds this level will be transferred to Residential Time-of-Day Rate 11.
- 2) Customers may become eligible again for Residential Service Rate 1 if their consumption remains below 7,600 kWh for twelve consecutive billing months. Customers will not be transferred automatically.

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- 3) Bed and Breakfast establishments with a total of five bedrooms or less at the premise shall be considered predominantly residential use and shall therefore be eligible for service under this rate schedule. Bed and Breakfast establishments with a total of six bedrooms or more that also demonstrate that they pay annual Vermont Rooms and Meals Tax of less than \$3,000 shall be considered predominantly residential use and shall therefore be eligible for service under this rate schedule.
- 4) For Customers who were receiving service under the Company's dual-fuel/storage heat program requiring two or more meters and who were converted to this rate on October 1, 2002, the Company may continue to meter the Customer's total service with two or more meters and the consumption at all meters will be added together for billing purposes and be billed to the Customer as one account.
- 5) The Company's other terms and conditions, where not inconsistent with any specific provisions hereof, are part of this rate schedule.
